# HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY TO CONVENE A GLOBAL  
ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE SUMMIT IN 2020.

1           WHEREAS, artificial intelligence is on track to be one of  
2 history's most impactful scientific advances; and

3  
4           WHEREAS, artificial intelligence is intelligence  
5 demonstrated by machine, wherein machines mimic human cognitive  
6 functions like learning and problem solving; and

7  
8           WHEREAS, the benefits of artificial intelligence currently  
9 outweigh its costs; and

10  
11           WHEREAS, advances in science are being used to benefit  
12 fields as diverse as trucking, medical diagnosis, and finance;  
13 and

14  
15           WHEREAS, however, many experts warn of the dangers  
16 associated with artificial intelligence, such as autonomous  
17 weapons, social manipulation, and invasion of personal privacy;  
18 and

20           WHEREAS, the United States and other global nations should  
21 examine the best ways to integrate and approach artificial  
22 intelligence to leverage its advantages and prepare against  
23 potential harm; and

25           WHEREAS, due to its central Pacific location and close  
26 proximity to Asia, Hawaii is an ideal place to host a global  
27 summit on artificial intelligence; now, therefore,

29           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
30 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of  
31 2019, that the Hawaii Tourism Authority is requested to convene  
32 a global artificial intelligence summit to be held in 2020; and

34           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the purpose of the summit shall  
35 be to gather experts from around the world to discuss  
36 innovations in artificial intelligence technologies and share

1 and develop practical applications for artificial intelligence  
2 technologies; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
