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## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO DISPLAY THE TEXT OF ANY SIGN THAT IS PERMANENTLY AFFIXED TO THE INTERIOR OR EXTERIOR OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN BOTH THE ENGLISH AND HAWAIIAN LANGUAGES.

1           WHEREAS, article X, section 4, of the Hawaii State  
2 Constitution provides that "[t]he State shall promote the study  
3 of Hawaiian culture, history and language"; and  
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5           WHEREAS, article XV, section 4, of the Hawaii State  
6 Constitution establishes Hawaiian as one of two official  
7 languages of the State; and  
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9           WHEREAS, the newly constructed Nanakuli Public Library is  
10 the first public library in the State to include signs that are  
11 posted in both the English and Hawaiian languages; and  
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13           WHEREAS, the inclusion of both the English and Hawaiian  
14 languages on signage in schools operated by the Department of  
15 Education will help to promote the Hawaiian language; now,  
16 therefore,  
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18           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
19 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of  
20 2019, that the Department of Education is requested to display  
21 in both the English and Hawaiian languages the text of any sign  
22 that is permanently affixed to the interior or exterior of a  
23 public school; and  
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
