HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FINANCE TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE FEASIBILITY OF CREATING A PROGRAM THAT WOULD ALLOW QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS TO REMIT VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEES ON A BIANNUAL BASIS.

WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that annual taxes and fees 1 2 collected when non-new motor vehicles are registered can have a dire impact on low-income individuals; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, these low-income individuals may not be able to pay the taxes and fees in one lump sum or may experience 6 7 financial hardship from doing so; and 8 WHEREAS, a possible solution to this issue would be to 9 allow low-income individuals, or persons deemed to be suffering 10 a financial hardship, to pay the registration taxes and fees on 11 a pro-rated biannual basis; now, therefore, 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 14 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 15 2019, that the Department of Budget and Finance is requested to 16 conduct a study on the feasibility of creating a program that 17 would allow qualified individuals to remit registration fees on 18 a biannual basis; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Budget and 21 Finance is requested to report the Department's findings and 22 recommendations to the Legislature no later than twenty days 23

prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2020; and
