# HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU'S DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION SERVICES TO CONTINUE EXPANSION OF THE  
RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE PROGRAM TO LILIHA AND PUUNUI.

1           WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that urban Honolulu is a  
2 densely populated area where an influx of new residents and  
3 monster homes bring additional cars into the city's  
4 neighborhoods; and

5  
6           WHEREAS, on-street parking is extremely limited and illegal  
7 parking is prevalent due to the increase of cars; and

8  
9           WHEREAS, one solution to ensure that homeowners have access  
10 to on-street parking spaces is to implement regulated restricted  
11 parking zones which require limited permits obtained through  
12 proof of area residency in order to utilize on-street parking;  
13 and

15           WHEREAS, Arlington, Virginia, has successfully implemented  
16 a residential permit parking program since 1977, and Los  
17 Angeles, California, has successfully implemented their  
18 preferential parking permit program since 1979; and

19  
20           WHEREAS, the Arlington, Virginia, residential permit  
21 parking zones program has expanded to include over 20 zones in  
22 areas such as Ashton Heights and Lyon Park; and

23  
24           WHEREAS, Hawaii has also successfully implemented a  
25 restricted parking zone program in Kalihi on Wilson Street in  
26 March of 2017; and

28           WHEREAS, a Hawaii News Now survey reported that 98.8  
29 percent of the residents participating in the Kalihi restricted  
30 parking zone program support the program and would support a  
31 permanent program; now, therefore,



# H.R. NO. 53

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
2 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of  
3 2019, that the City and County of Honolulu's Department of  
4 Transportation Services is requested and encouraged to continue  
5 the expansion of the restricted zone parking program to the  
6 Liliha and Puunui areas; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
9 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City and County of  
10 Honolulu, Director of Transportation Services of the City and  
11 County of Honolulu, Chair of the Honolulu City Council, and the  
12 Chair of the Liliha/Puunui/Alewa Neighborhood Board No. 14.
