
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that farmers and ranchers
2 are vulnerable to natural disasters. In 2018, farmers and
3 ranchers suffered through floods from severe weather statewide
4 and volcanic eruptions on the island of Hawaii. The university
5 of Hawaii college of tropical agriculture and human resources
6 reported a total of \$27,900,000 in farm losses caused by the
7 Kilauea eruptions, and the National Weather Service estimates
8 that farmers on Kauai and Oahu reported losses of \$19,700,000
9 due to severe weather. Agricultural disaster recovery efforts
10 need to be carried out quickly and efficiently to ensure that
11 damaged farm infrastructure, crops, and land are restored as
12 soon as possible.

13 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
14 department of agriculture's agricultural loan program to provide
15 loans to local farmers and ranchers who have experienced losses
16 caused by disasters.



1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 to be
4 deposited into the agricultural loan revolving fund.

5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the agricultural
6 loan revolving fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 to provide loans
8 pursuant to chapter 155, part I, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
9 support local ranchers and farmers who have experienced losses
10 caused by disasters.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
12 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
