# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) The department of business, economic  
2 development, and tourism shall conduct a study on potential  
3 areas for economic development, other than tourism, for the  
4 county of Hawaii. In conducting the study, the department of  
5 business, economic development, and tourism shall research  
6 potential means of expanding the manufacturing industry in the  
7 county of Hawaii.

8           (b) The department of business, economic development, and  
9 tourism shall submit a report of its findings and  
10 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the  
11 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of  
12 the regular session of 2020.

13           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so  
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 for  
16 the department of business, economic development, and tourism to


1 conduct a study on potential areas of economic development,
