
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYEE'S DESIGNATION OF BENEFICIARY FORM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 78-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3 "(c) Upon discharge, an employee shall be entitled to all
4 of the employee's accumulated vacation allowance plus the
5 employee's current accrued vacation allowance to and including
6 the date of discharge, notwithstanding that the current accrued
7 vacation allowance may not have been recorded at the time. If
8 any employee dies with accumulated or current accrued vacation
9 earned but not taken, an amount equal to the value of the
10 employee's pay over the period of such earned vacation, and any
11 earned and unpaid wages, shall be paid to the person or persons
12 who may have been designated as the beneficiary or beneficiaries
13 by the employee during the employee's lifetime in a [verified
14 ~~written~~] statement filed with the comptroller or other
15 disbursing officer who issues warrants or checks to pay the
16 employee for the employee's services as a public employee, or



1 with the department in which the employee was employed, or,
2 failing the designation, to the employee's estate."

3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2051.

Employee's Designation of Beneficiary Form

Description:

Allows a state department employee's designation of beneficiary form to be kept in the department where the employee is employed. Eliminates the requirement that the designation be a verified written statement. Takes effect on 1/1/2051. (SD1)

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
