A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVER'S LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-106, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§286-106 Expiration of licenses.** Every driver's license
4 issued under this part, except for a provisional license issued
5 under section 286-102.6 which shall expire on the date of the
6 provisional licensee's nineteenth birthday, whether an original
7 issuance or a renewal, shall expire on the first birthday of the
8 licensee occurring not less than eight years after the date of
9 the issuance of the license, unless sooner revoked or suspended;
10 provided that:

11 (1) The license shall expire on the first birthday of the
12 licensee occurring not less than four years after the
13 date of the issuance if, at the time, the licensee is
14 twenty-four years of age or younger;

15 (2) The license shall expire on the first birthday of the
16 licensee occurring not less than four years after the
17 date of the issuance of the license if, at that time,



1 the licensee is between seventy-two years of age and
2 seventy-nine years of age;

3 ~~[(2)]~~ (3) The license shall expire on the first birthday of
4 the licensee occurring not less than two years after
5 the date of the issuance of the license if, at that
6 time, the licensee is ~~[seventy-two]~~ eighty years of
7 age or older; and

8 ~~[(3)]~~ (4) If the licensee is a legal immigrant, the license
9 shall expire no later than the licensee's authorized
10 period of stay in the United States.

11 The examiner of drivers may issue a license for a shorter
12 period if the licensee has a physical condition or conditions
13 that the examiner of drivers reasonably believes may impair the
14 driver's ability to drive."

15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
