# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CONSOLIDATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER'S LICENSE  
AND CIVIL IDENTIFICATION CARD FORMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-111, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:  
3 "(a) Every application for an instruction permit,  
4 provisional license, driver's license, limited purpose driver's  
5 license, limited purpose provisional driver's license, or  
6 limited purpose instruction permit shall be made upon a form  
7 developed by the director. The director shall develop an  
8 application form that consolidates the application under this  
9 section and the application under section 286-303. The form  
10 shall be furnished by the examiner of drivers and shall be  
11 verified by the applicant before a person authorized to  
12 administer oaths. The examiner of drivers and officers serving  
13 under the examiner may administer the oaths without charge.  
14 Each application for an instruction permit for a category (1),  
15 (2), (3), or (4) license shall be accompanied by a fee to be  
16 determined by the council of each county, and each application



1 for a provisional license or driver's license shall be  
2 accompanied by the fee, unless the applicant has already paid  
3 the fee upon application for an instruction permit in the same  
4 county, in which event no fee shall be charged. An additional  
5 fee to be determined by the council of each county shall be  
6 charged and collected upon the issuance of a provisional license  
7 or driver's license. All of the foregoing fees shall become  
8 county realizations."

9 SECTION 2. Section 286-303, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
10 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

11 "(c) Every application for an identification card or  
12 duplicate of an identification card shall be made on a form  
13 developed by the director pursuant to section 286-111 and  
14 furnished by the examiner of drivers, signed by the applicant,  
15 and signed by the applicant's parent or guardian if the  
16 applicant is under eighteen years of age. The application shall  
17 contain the following information:

- 18 (1) Name and complete address, including the number and  
19 street name, of the applicant's permanent residence;
- 20 (2) The applicant's occupation and any pertinent data  
21 relating thereto;



- 1           (3) The applicant's citizenship status;
- 2           (4) The applicant's veteran status if applicable and
- 3                 desired by the applicant;
- 4           (5) The applicant's date and place of birth;
- 5           (6) General description of the applicant, including the
- 6                 applicant's gender, height, weight, hair color, and
- 7                 eye color;
- 8           (7) The applicant's left and right index fingerprints or,
- 9                 if clear impressions cannot be obtained, other
- 10                identifying imprints as specified by rules of the
- 11                director;
- 12           (8) The social security number of the applicant; and
- 13           (9) A digitized frontal photograph of the applicant's full
- 14                face.

15 Each applicant shall present documentary evidence as required by  
16 the examiner of drivers of the applicant's age and identity, and  
17 the applicant shall swear or affirm that all information given  
18 is true and correct."

19           SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
