# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§302A-           Epinephrine administration. (a) Each public  
5 or private school shall have staff trained in the administration  
6 of epinephrine. The minimum number of trained staff members  
7 shall be the greater of one trained staff member per:

8           (1) One hundred students; or

9           (2) Floor of each school building to which students have  
10           access.

11           (b) Each public or private school shall prominently  
12 display clearly legible signs in school buildings stating the  
13 symptoms of anaphylaxis and the proper method for administering  
14 epinephrine.

15           (c) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter  
16 91 to implement this section."



# S.B. NO. 343

1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much  
 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the  
 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year  
 5 2020-2021 for the training of public school staff members in the  
 6 administration of epinephrine.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
 8 of education for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
