1	(5) Any person who drives or operates state or county
2	motor vehicles while employed by, in the service of,
3	or volunteering for the state or county fire
4	departments[$_{ au}$]; provided that they are trained and
5	certified to drive category (4) motor vehicles as set
6	forth in section 286-102(b)(4) by the state or county
7	government, as appropriate[, and]; provided further
8	that the person maintains a category (3) license as
9	set forth in section 286-102(b)(3)."
10	SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
11	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
12	begun before its effective date.
13	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
