A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS
2	SECTION 1. Unless otherwise clear from the context, as
3	used in this Act:
4	"Expending agency" means the department of agriculture.
5	Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency,
6	shall mean the following:
7	AGR Department of agriculture
8	"Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which
9	funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the
10	programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations
11	are followed by letter symbols. Such letter symbols, where
12	used, shall have the following meanings:
13	A General funds
14	B Special funds
15	"Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent
16	and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a
17	particular program during a specified period or periods. as

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- 1 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent
- 2 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent
- 3 positions.
- 4 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific
- 5 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization
- 6 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the
- 7 organization number for the program.
- 8 PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS
- 9 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
- 10 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
- 11 herein, are hereby appropriated or authorized, as the case may
- 12 be, from the means of financing specified to the expending
- 13 agencies designated for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1,
- 14 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The total expenditures and the
- 15 number of positions in each fiscal year of the biennium shall
- 16 not exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
- 17 fiscal year, except as provided elsewhere in this Act or as
- 18 provided by general law.

- 2 SECTION 3. Provided that of the general fund appropriation
- 3 for quality and price assurance (AGR151), the sum of \$89,878 or
- 4 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020
- 5 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 6 fiscal year 2020-2021 shall be expended for a commodities
- 7 program manager.
- 8 SECTION 4. Provided that of the general fund appropriation
- 9 for quality and price assurance (AGR151), the sum of \$84,612 or
- 10 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020
- 11 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 12 fiscal year 2020-2021 shall be expended for an agricultural
- 13 commodities marketing specialist V.
- 14 SECTION 5. Provided that of the special fund appropriation
- 15 for quality and price assurance (AGR151), the sum of \$66,708 or
- 16 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020
- 17 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 18 fiscal year 2020-2021 shall be expended for an agricultural
- 19 commodities marketing specialist V.
- 20 SECTION 6. Provided that of the general fund appropriation
- 21 for quality and price assurance (AGR151), the sum of \$46,932 or
- 22 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020

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- 1 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 2 fiscal year 2020-2021 shall be expended for an agricultural
- 3 commodities marketing specialist III.
- 4 SECTION 7. Provided that of the special fund appropriation
- 5 for measurement standards (AGR812), the sum of \$153,936 or so
- 6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
- 7 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 8 year 2020-2021 shall be expended for three (3.00) measurement
- 9 standards inspector V.
- 10 SECTION 8. Provided that of the special fund appropriation
- 11 for measurement standards (AGR812), the sum of \$77,256 or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
- 13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 14 year 2020-2021 shall be expended for a measurement standards
- 15 program manager.
- 16 SECTION 9. Provided that of the general fund appropriation
- 17 for general administration (AGR192), the sum of \$94,932 or so
- 18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
- 19 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 20 year 2020-2021 shall be expended for an administrative services
- 21 officer.

1 SECTION 10. Provided that, notwithstanding any provision 2 contained in the General Appropriations Act of 2019 that 3 appropriates funds and establishes position ceilings, the 4 positions authorized in section 2 shall be in addition to the 5 positions authorized for that program under the General 6 Appropriations Act of 2019; provided further that any incumbent 7 employee shall retain the employee's: 8 (1) Civil service status, whether permanent or temporary; 9 and 10 (2) Salary, seniority (except as may be prescribed by 11 applicable collective bargaining agreement), retention 12 points, prior service credit, any vacation and sick 13 leave credits previously earned, and other rights, 14 benefits, and privileges, in accordance with state 15 personnel laws. 16 SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, 17 provided that the funds appropriated in this Act may be 18 transferred with the approval of the governor to the General 19 Appropriations Act of 2019 (House Bill No. 2, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, 20 C.D.1), for program execution and expenditure. 21 SECTION 12. If any portion of this Act or its application

to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for

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- 1 any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of
- 2 the Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be
- 3 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
- 4 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
- 5 be expended to fulfill the objective of such appropriation to
- 6 the extent possible.
- 7 SECTION 13. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other
- 8 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may
- 9 correct the errors.
- 10 SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect on June 28, 2019.
