A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GRANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 as a
4 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
5 Hospice of Hilo for capacity building for the community-based
6 palliative care program.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
8 health for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 as a
12 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the
13 Maui Economic Development Board, Inc., for the multifaceted
14 science, technology, engineering, and mathematics education
15 program for K-12 students and teachers, including curriculum,
16 professional development, career awareness, and work-based
17 learning.

7 Hospice Inc., for the community-based palliative care program.


8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
