# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 302A-1128, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "**§302A-1128 Department powers and duties.** The department  
4 shall have entire charge and control and be responsible for the  
5 conduct of all affairs pertaining to public instruction in the  
6 public schools the department establishes and operates [~~7~~  
7 ~~including operating and maintaining the capital improvement and~~  
8 ~~repair and maintenance programs for department and school~~  
9 ~~facilities]~~. The department may establish and maintain schools  
10 for secular instruction at such places and for such terms as in  
11 its discretion it may deem advisable and the funds at its  
12 disposal may permit. The schools may include high schools,  
13 kindergarten schools, schools or classes for early childhood  
14 education, boarding schools, Hawaiian language medium education  
15 schools, and evening and day schools. The department may also  
16 maintain classes for technical and other instruction in any  
17 school where there may not be pupils sufficient in number to

1 justify the establishment of separate schools for these  
2 purposes."

3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
4 and stricken.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
