A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The Hawaii public housing authority shall adopt 2 rules without regard to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to 3 establish a program to reimburse land owners who participate in 4 the section 8 housing voucher program to cover repair costs of 5 tenant-caused property damage when the repair costs exceed the 6 tenant's security deposit. 7 There is appropriated out of the general SECTION 2. revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 8 or so 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and 10 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 11 year 2020-2021 to the Hawaii public housing authority to 12 reimburse landlords who participate in the section 8 housing 13 choice voucher program for repair costs of tenant-caused 14 property damage when such repair costs exceed the tenant's 15 security deposit and to establish one full time-equivalent (1.0

FTE) position to assist and administer the reimbursement

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 2 public housing authority for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
