SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES, DIVISION OF FORESTRY AND WILDLIFE TO DOCUMENT THE HISTORY OF EXEMPLARY CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY COMMUNITY MEMBERS, INCLUDING KUPUNA, CONSERVATIONISTS, AND CITIZENS.

1 WHEREAS, one of the obligations of the State of Hawaii is
2 to document the history of its work; and

4 WHEREAS, many key community members, kupuna,
5 conservationists, and citizens have played an integral role in
6 the preservation of critical conservation lands; and

8 WHEREAS, the role of citizen participation in natural
9 resources management should be celebrated and encouraged; now,
10 therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature
13 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2019, the House of
14 Representatives concurring, that the Department of Land and
15 Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife is urged to
16 document the history of exemplary contributions made by
17 community members, including kupuna, conservationists, and
18 citizens; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
21 Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife is urged to
22 honor the selected individuals by highlighting their names,
23 backgrounds, and contributions at associated sites without
24 displacing any Hawaiian place names; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
27 Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife is urged to
28 begin the documentation of exemplary contributions made by
29 community members by choosing a site to honor the story of
30 Marjorie Yasue Fern Ziegler, whose life's work had unparalleled
31 impact on Hawaii's conservation landscape; and

 2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
 3 Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife is urged to
 4 include on its website the story of each individual who is
 5 recognized; the location that the Division of Forestry and
 6 Wildlife has selected to honor each individual's story; and why
 7 the Division of Forestry and Wildlife selected the location, so
 8 that each recognized individual's background and contributions
 9 can be memorialized for future generations; and

 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 12 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor,
 13 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, and
 14 Administrator of the Division of Forestry and Wildlife for the
 15 Department of Land and Natural Resources.
