- (1) Establish the Hawaii Correctional System Oversight
 Commission to be headed by an Oversight Coordinator, to
 oversee the State's correctional system, investigate
 complaints at correctional facilities, manage capacity
 of correctional facilities, and manage the Comprehensive
 Offender Reentry System;
- (2) Transfer all rights, powers, functions, and duties of the Reentry Commission and Corrections Population Management Commission to the Hawaii Correctional System Oversight Commission; and
- (3) Abolish the Reentry Commission and Corrections Population Management Commission.

The Department of Public Safety, Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Community Alliance on Prisons, O'ahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, Hawai'i

Health & Harm Reduction Center, and a few concerned individuals testified in support of this measure. The Hawaii Paroling Authority and The Civil Beat Law Center for the Public Interest provided comments.
