Your Committee on Intrastate Commerce, to which was referred
H.B. No. 63 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO REAL ESTATE LICENSES,"

The purpose of this measure is to require a high school
education or its equivalent as a condition for obtaining a license
as a real estate broker or real estate salesperson.

The Hawaii Real Estate Commission, Hawaii Association of
REALTORS, and a few concerned individuals testified in support of
this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its
effective date to July 1, 3000.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Intrastate Commerce that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
No. 63, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second
Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 63, H.D. 1, and be
referred to your Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
