Sir:

Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred H.B. No. 788 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require a law enforcement officer to issue a citation to any person who operates a vehicle registered in Hawaii without a valid registration tag or emblem, or a valid inspection sticker.

The Department of Transportation, Honolulu Police Department, and one individual testified in support of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2050, to promote further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 788, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading



in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 788, H.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Judiciary.
