energy technology and infrastructure by:

- (1) Transferring the administration of the Building Energy
Efficiency Revolving Loan Fund to the Hawaii Green
Infrastructure Authority;
- (2) Expanding the purpose of the Building Energy Efficiency
Revolving Loan Fund to include a broader range of clean
energy technologies and renaming it as the Clean Energy
Revolving Loan Fund; and
- (3) Making an appropriation out of the Clean Energy
Revolving Loan Fund to make clean energy investment
loans or for other approved uses.
