Your Committee on Public Safety, Veterans, & Military
Affairs, to which was referred H.B. No. 990 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE
FACILITIES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to clarify:

- (1) The organizations and activities that the Department of
Defense may rent their facilities to; and
- (2) That the Department of Defense may retain revenues
collected to cover the cost of utilities, supplies,
personnel, and wear-and-tear associated with the lending
out of its facilities and that any net proceeds
collected associated with the lending out of its
facilities will be returned to the general fund, with
required amounts returned to the Office of Hawaiian
Affairs.

The Department of Defense supported this measure.




Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion on this measure; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Public Safety, Veterans, & Military Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 990, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 990, H.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Finance.
