Your Committee on Lower & Higher Education, to which was referred H.B. No. 995 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII TEACHER STANDARDS BOARD,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to clarify the delegation of powers to the Hawaii Teacher Standard Board's Executive Director to timely approve license and permit applications, to include comprehensive reporting of data from the Department of Education, Charter School Commission, and charter schools, of the number of classrooms without a licensed teacher during the school year.

The Hawai'i Teacher Standards Board, State Public Charter School Commission, and Hawaii State Teachers Association supported this measure. The Department of Education offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion on this measure.


