Your Committees on Economic Development & Business and
Agriculture, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 107 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF
BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM AND DEPARTMENT OF

The purpose of this measure is to:

submit a report to the Legislature prior to the 2020
