LLC, Paradise Action Women's Alliance, and many individuals
supported this measure. The Legislative Reference Bureau and CTIA
provided comments.

Your Committees have amended this measure by specifying that
scientific data on 5G shall be included in the Legislative
Reference Bureau's study on 5G wireless technology.
