ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM AND DEPARTMENT OF  
AGRICULTURE TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING A STATEWIDE  
PROGRAM TO ADDRESS AGRICULTURAL THEFT,"

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Request the Department of Business, Economic  
Development, and Tourism (DBEDT) and the Department of

- (2) Request DBEDT and the Department of Agriculture to  
submit a report to the Legislature prior to the 2020  
Regular Session.
