Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred H.R. No. 145 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO COLLABORATE WITH THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO ENHANCE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY AT THE INTERSECTION OF ALA MOANA BOULEVARD AND KAMAKEE STREET,"

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of Transportation collaborate with the Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu to conduct a study to enhance pedestrian safety at the intersection of Ala Moana Boulevard and Kamakee Street.

The Department of Transportation, Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu, and The Howard Hughes Corporation testified in support of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Inserting language requesting the Department of Transportation to work with appropriate private




entities, in addition to the City and County of Honolulu;
