The purpose of this measure is to request the Legislative  
Reference Bureau to conduct a study that summarizes the salient  
points of existing published reports and studies from reputable

to the biological life of Hawaii.

A few individuals supported this measure. CTIA provided  
comments.

Your Committees have amended this measure by specifying that  
scientific data on 5G shall be included in the Legislative  
Reference Bureau's study on 5G wireless technology.

with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 178, as amended herein,


