Your Committee on Human Services & Homelessness, to which was referred H.R. No. 73 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONSPICUOUSLY POST CLEARLY LEGIBLE SIGNS AT EACH PUBLIC PARK OR BEACH WITHIN THE AREA OF OAHU BOUNDED BY KALAELOA AND MAKAHA THAT DISPLAY THE TELEPHONE NUMBERS OR HOTLINE NUMBERS OF ANY COUNTY OR STATE AGENCY THAT PROVIDES ASSISTANCE TO HOMELESS PERSONS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure to request the Department of Land and Natural Resources to conspicuously post clearly legible signs at each public park or beach within the area of Oahu bounded by Kalaeloa and Makaha that display the telephone numbers or hotline numbers of any County or State agency that provides assistance to homeless persons.

Your Committee received testimony from the Department of Land and Natural Resources and the Governor's Coordinator on Homelessness providing comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by requesting the Department of Land and Natural Resources and the City and County of Honolulu to conspicuously post clearly legible signs at each public park or beach or State lands within the area of Oahu
