Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred S.B.  
No. 1174 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HAWAII CRIMINAL JUSTICE DATA  
CENTER FEES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to provide  
authority for the Hawaii Criminal Justice Data Center to set and  
collect fees for services provided.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Department of the Attorney General and Department of  
Public Safety.

Your Committee finds that the services provided by the Hawaii  
Criminal Justice Data Center are valuable to law enforcement and  
correctional officers. Your Committee further finds that the  
enumerated services for which the Hawaii Criminal Justice Data  
Center can currently assess fees do not include all services  
offered by the Center. This measure gives the Hawaii Criminal  
Justice Data Center greater flexibility in matching its fee  
structure to the services that it offers.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:



- (1) Clarifying that fees assessed by the Hawaii Criminal Justice Data Center must be reasonable and necessary; and
- (2) Making a technical, nonsubstantive amendment for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Judiciary that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 1174, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 1174, S.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.
