Your Committee on Health, to which was referred S.B. No. 203
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO VACCINATIONS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to allow licensed pharmacists
to administer vaccinations or immunizations required under chapter
325, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

The Board of Pharmacy, Daniel K. Inouye College of Pharmacy
at the University of Hawai'i at Hilo, Hawai'i Public Health
Association, Hawai'i Immunization Coalition, and several
individuals testified in support of this measure. The Department
of Health provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing the
effective date to July 1, 2050, to promote further discussion.

Your Committee finds that the ability of trained pharmacists
to provide access to preventive treatment in a timely manner is
essential to the health and welfare of the State.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
