Your Committees on Health and Intrastate Commerce, to which was referred S.B. No. 307, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SPEECH PATHOLOGY,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to allow for the provisional licensure of speech pathologists engaging in academic or clinical practice under the supervision of a licensed speech pathologist.

The Board of Speech Pathology and Audiology, Hilo Medical Center, Healthcare Association of Hawaii, Hawaii Speech and Hearing Association, Aegis Therapies, O'ahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, and several individuals testified in support of this measure. One individual provided comments.

Your Committees have amended this measure by:

- (1) Inserting a purpose section clarifying that this measure seeks to address a statewide shortage of speech pathologists; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.


