Your Committee on Intrastate Commerce, to which was referred  
S.B. No. 385, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL  
LICENSING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to repeal defaults on student  
loans, student loan repayment contracts, and scholarship contracts  
as grounds for sanctioning professional and vocational licensees.

The O'ahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the  
Democratic Party of Hawai'i testified in support of this measure.  
The Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs commented on this  
measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Re-inserting statutory language that allows the right to  
a hearing and appeal from an order suspending, revoking,  
or refusing to extend any license application by the  
Insurance Commissioner;
- (2) Changing its effective date to July 1, 3000; and



- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Intrastate Commerce that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 385, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 385, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
