Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 23 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO ESTABLISH A TASK FORCE TO REVIEW HAWAII'S CURRENT VOTER EDUCATION SYSTEM AND PROPOSE IMPROVEMENTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to:

- (1) Request the Legislative Reference Bureau to establish a task force to review Hawaii's current voter education system and propose improvements; and
- (2) Request that the task force submit preliminary and final reports to the Legislature.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Office of Elections, League of Women Voters of Hawaii, Common Cause Hawaii, and two individuals. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Legislative Reference Bureau and Disability and Communication Access Board.

Your Committee finds that the lack of balanced, politically nonpartisan, and readily available voter education is a significant factor that contributes to poor citizen engagement. Your Committee further finds that an appropriate voter education program should also accommodate bilingual voters, disabled voters,

and voters who are voting for the first time. This measure requests that the Legislative Reference Bureau establish a task force to review voter education in the State and propose improvements.
