Your Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental, and
Military Affairs, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 25 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE POLICE DEPARTMENTS
OF EACH COUNTY TO ADOPT NEW FIREWORKS DETECTION TECHNOLOGIES
TO ENFORCE FIREWORKS LAWS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to urge the county
police departments to adopt new fireworks detection technologies
to enforce fireworks laws.

Your Committee did not receive any testimony on this measure.

Your Committee finds that certain new technologies allow law
enforcement officers to instantly detect and locate gunshots could
be adapted to detect the explosion of a firework. Your Committee
further finds that these technologies will better equip county
police to enforce fireworks laws by informing police, almost
instantaneously, where illicit fireworks are being set off. Your
Committee therefore finds that this measure urges the county
police departments to adopt products that can instantly detect and
locate fireworks to assist in the enforcement of fireworks laws.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental, and Military
Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs



with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 25 and recommends that it be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.


