## **DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):**

SB651 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. AEN, WAM

Status and Testimony Inserts a definition for "bona fide farmer" that applies to the non-

agricultural park lands program. Exempts individual members, trustees, officers, and stockholders of certain entities from the required individual qualifications of a "bona fide farmer".

SB760 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. AEN, WAM

Status and Testimony Clarifies definition of "qualified agricultural costs." Extends

through the 2029 taxable year the time in which the Department of Agriculture may certify important agricultural lands qualified agricultural cost tax credits. Applies to taxable years beginning

after 12/31/2019.
