HB 1103, HD2 (HSCR846) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE PESTICIDE SUBSIDY PROGRAM. Appropriates moneys to the Department of Agriculture for the pesticide subsidy program. Effective 7/1/2150. (HB1103 HD2)	AEN, WAM
