HB 547  
Status

RELATING TO FARMS.  
Creates an exclusion from income tax for the lesser of fifty-one per cent of gross annual income or \$50,000 of gross annual income earned by a farmer from farming activities.

HB 616  
Status

RELATING TO TAXATION.  
Exempts locally grown produce and locally raised livestock food products from the general excise tax.




Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
