**SB 527** RELATING TO CANNABIS FOR MEDICAL USE. Pending re-referral Authorizes and regulates the manufacturing of edible cannabis Status & products as manufactured cannabis products by licensed CPH, WAM Testimony medical cannabis dispensaries. Establishes standards, including regulations and education protocols, for edible cannabis products. Requires cannabis and manufactured cannabis products to include a universal symbol, developed by the department of health, to identify any product containing cannabis. Requires the department of health to implement a cannabis product recall system. RELATING TO HEALTH. CPH, JDC **SB 1237** Authorizes State Health Planning and Development Agency to Status & mandate the submission of Medicare Advantage (Medicare Part Testimony C) administrative data and healthcare services claims. RELATING TO TELEHEALTH. **SB 1246** CPH, WAM Establishes goals for the adoption and proliferation of telehealth Status & to increase health care access. Establishes the Strategic Testimony Telehealth Advisory Council and permanent full-time State Telehealth Coordinator position. RELATING TO HEALTH. **SB 1010** CPH, WAM Codifies certain developmental disabilities under the Department Status & of Health. **Testimony** RELATING TO THE BOARD OF HEALTH. CPH, JDC **SB 1383** Abolishes the board of health. Status & **Testimony** RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH. CPH, WAM **SB 1121** Establishes a working group to examine and advise on Status & amendments that can be made to the statutory description of the Testimony department of health's powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities in the Hawaii Revised Statutes. Appropriates

funds to support the activities of the working group.

Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SUICIDE PREVENTION.  Appropriates moneys for youth suicide early intervention, prevention, and education initiatives in Kauai and Hawaii counties.	CPH, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HEALTH.  Appropriates funds to improve health care services related to cardiac care at Hilo Medical Center.	CPH, WAM
