<u>SB 527</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO CANNABIS FOR MEDICAL USE. Authorizes and regulates the manufacturing of edible cannabis products as manufactured cannabis products by licensed medical cannabis dispensaries. Establishes standards, including regulations and education protocols, for edible cannabis products. Requires cannabis and manufactured cannabis products to include a universal symbol, developed by the department of health, to identify any product containing cannabis. Requires the department of health to implement a cannabis product recall system.	Pending re-referral to: CPH, WAM
<u>SB 1237</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Authorizes State Health Planning and Development Agency to mandate the submission of Medicare Advantage (Medicare Part C) administrative data and healthcare services claims.	CPH, JDC
<u>SB 1246</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO TELEHEALTH. Establishes goals for the adoption and proliferation of telehealth to increase health care access. Establishes the Strategic Telehealth Advisory Council and permanent full-time State Telehealth Coordinator position.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 1010</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Codifies certain developmental disabilities under the Department of Health.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 1383</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE BOARD OF HEALTH. Abolishes the board of health.	CPH, JDC
<u>SB 1121</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH. Establishes a working group to examine and advise on amendments that can be made to the statutory description of the department of health's powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities in the Hawaii Revised Statutes. Appropriates funds to support the activities of the working group.	CPH, WAM

<u>SB 104</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Appropriates moneys for the department of health's lead poisoning prevention activities.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 226</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO SUICIDE PREVENTION. Appropriates moneys for youth suicide early intervention, prevention, and education initiatives in Kauai and Hawaii counties.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 911</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Appropriates funds to improve health care services related to cardiac care at Hilo Medical Center.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 1410</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO EMERGENCY SERVICES. Appropriates funds to increase the bed count at the Ka'u hospital emergency room by four beds.	CPH, WAM
