SB1043 RELATING TO HEALTH CARE. CPH, JDC

Status and Testimony Requires health insurers, mutual benefit societies, and health

maintenance organizations to provide coverage for a

comprehensive category of reproductive health services, drugs, devices, products, and procedures. Prohibits discrimination in the

provision of reproductive health care services.

SB1033 RELATING TO THE LICENSURE OF MIDWIVES. CPH, JDC/WAM

<u>Status and Testimony</u> Establishes licensure of midwives including scope of practice,

professional code of conduct, continuing education requirements, and prescriptive drug authority. Appropriates funds from the compliance resolution fund. Exempts traditional birth attendants and Native Hawaiian healers from licensure requirements.
