HB 821 Status

RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS.

EDB/IAC, FIN

Authorizes the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to enter into a public-private partnership to plan, build, and manage key strategic broadband infrastructure that benefits the State, including a cable landing station in Kakaako, on the island of Oahu, and to encourage cloud-based companies to take advantage of this infrastructure. Exempts the partnership from certain state and county

laws. Appropriates funds.

HB 1156 Status

RELATING TO BROADBAND SERVICE INFRASTRUCTURE.

Establishes the broadband service infrastructure grant program to award grants to applicants to extend deployment of facilities used to provide broadband service to unserved and underserved areas of the

State. Makes an appropriation.
