Establishes a general excise tax holiday for consumers and businesses for school supplies sold during the weekend beginning with the last Friday in July; provided that businesses pass the savings on to consumers. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

Status

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.
Repeals the annual \$35,000,000 rolling cap and extends the repeal date for the motion picture, digital media, and film production income tax credit; provided that title to a certain parcel of University of Hawaii – West Oahu land is successfully transferred to the Hawaii Technology Development Corporation. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD3)

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:


PAPER: 23 copies (including an original) to Room 310 in the State Capitol;
