<u>HB 648</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO UNFAIR AND DECEPTIVE PRACTICES. Makes it an unfair and deceptive practice to charge mileage or travel fees to customers for the delivery of goods and services except as otherwise specified.	EDB, JUD, FIN
<u>HB 887</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Includes certain spirits-based beverages in the definition of cooler beverage. Repeals definition of draft beer. Applies the same tax rate to all beer.	EDB, CPC, FIN
<u>HB 1338</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. Establishes within the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism the China-Hawaii Economic Council to further economic relations between China and Hawaii. Appropriates funds.	EDB, TIA, FIN
<u>HB 1511</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE COMMUNITY-BASED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COUNCIL. Requires the Community-Based Economic Development Advisory Council to retain and oversee professional research and analysis services for the evaluation of the means or barriers for private for-profit start-up agricultural businesses to acquire funds for agriculture infrastructure projects.	EDB, AGR, FIN
<u>HB 340</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HAWAII TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. Appropriates funds to the Hawaii technology development corporation for the small business innovation research program.	EDB, FIN




<u>HB 338</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. Makes an appropriation into and out of the research and development special fund for the research and development program of the Hawaii technology development corporation.	EDB, FIN
<u>HB 774</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE ALTERNATIVE ENERGY RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT FUND. Appropriates funds into and out of the alternative energy research and development revolving fund for the Hawaii technology development corporation to provide grants.	EDB, FIN
<u>HB 623</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. Repeals Act 67, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, relating to alternative energy research and funding. Repeals Act 141, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, relating to the research and development program in the Hawaii technology development corporation.	EDB, FIN
