Status & Testimony	RELATING TO EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES. Allows home schooled students to participate on an equal basis in extracurricular activities offered at the public school they would otherwise be required to attend.	EDU, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS. Increases the amount of damages allowed for public school restitution agreements from \$3,500 to \$10,000.	EDU, JDC/WAM
SB 1071 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO IMPROVEMENTS TO STATE FACILITIES ON STATE LAND AT KA'OHAO PUBLIC CONVERSION CHARTER SCHOOL. Appropriates funds for a capital improvement project to state facilities on state land at Ka'ohao public conversion charter school.	EDU, WAM
