<a href="#">HB622 HD2</a> <a href="#">(HSCR1249)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOLS. Establishes new reporting requirement for charter schools. Requires establishment of a purchase order system to pay charter school expenses. Requires authorizers to select the independent auditors.
