HB 1585 Status

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

EEP/TRN, CPC, FIN

Establishes an electric vehicle charging system rebate program within the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism that provides rebates to persons who install a new electric vehicle charging system or upgrade an existing electric vehicle charging system. Caps the total value of rebates issued each year at an unspecified sum. Creates, and appropriates moneys out of, the electric vehicle charging station rebate program special fund. Amends the distribution of revenue from the environmental response, energy, and food security

tax. Prohibits the use of moneys from the energy security special fund to support the state energy office.
