SB 1000, SD2 (SSCR867)

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

EEP/TRN, CPC

Status

Prohibits, on or after January 1, 2020, the issuance of building permits for all new residential multi-family buildings that have ten or more parking stalls and new commercial buildings that have twenty or more parking stalls unless at least twenty per cent of the parking stalls are

electric vehicle charger ready. (SD2)

SB 653, SD2 (SSCR1072) Status

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

EEP/TRN, FIN

Requires certain new state and county building construction and reconstruction projects to dedicate at least twenty per cent of the total projected amount of parking stalls, but not less than two electric parking stalls, to be electric vehicle charger ready. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
