CORPORATION.

Status & Makes an appropriation into and out of the research and **Testimony** development special fund for the research and development

program of the Hawaii technology development corporation.

SB 717 RELATED TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS.

Requires members in planned community associations subject Status & to HRS 421J and unit owners in condominiums subject to HRS **Testimony**

514B to register units leased as transient accommodations. Requires associations to submit annual reports to county planning departments and Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism (DBEDT). Requires DBEDT to
