SB 1062 RELATING TO WASTE MANAGEMENT. GVO/PSM, WAM

Status & Requires that all state and county agency contractors that dispose of liquid or solid waste provide a receipt that the waste was received and disposed of at a licensed facility or an

was received and disposed of at a licensed facility or an appropriate farm or construction site before full payment is made for those contractual services. Allows for partial payment to be made without a receipt and prior to any dumping of waste.

Prohibits alteration or falsification of receipts.
