(HB169 HD1) RELATING TO AN OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS. **HB 1307** GVO, JDC/WAM Requires the Legislative Reference Bureau to conduct a study (HSCR833) on establishing a state central hearing agency to be known as the Office of Administrative Hearings and submit a report of its Status &

findings and recommendations, including any proposed

legislation, to the Legislature prior to the Regular Session of

2020.
